HISTORY

The estate, located in Saint-Androny, 4 km from Blaye, is planted on clay-limestone slopes overlooking the right bank of the Gironde, opposite the Médoc vineyards. The red wines of the Blaye-Côtes de Bordeaux appellation are made exclusively from Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot and Malbec grapes. They have an expressive bouquet, combining power and fruitiness.
